Behavior Data:

43 total incidents for the year, and increase of 13 this past month
January 20 behavior training for teachers was very valuable. The faculty will be

Academic Data:

Ellen Stone interpreted the data and progress from the January math and reading (Dibles and SRI) testing. (See attached data). Third graders were given the SRI for the first time. This will give teachers a better understanding of students' comprehension. The Committee reported that the Jan. 27 lunch reward activity was enjoyed by students. The March reward will be a Read-A-Thon, "Camp Out With a Good Book."

- 4. Budgetary Items: With the passage of Amendment B, the Trustlands Funds should increase next year by approximately \$10,000.00. In preparation for next year's CSIP plan, the committee discussed funding additional aides next year, possibly to help with Math and behavior (lunch and playground). The CSIP is due at the end of March.
