SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

The Canyons School District announces the sponsorship of the Summer Food Service Program. Free meals will be made available to attending children 18 years or younger.

Meals will be served 8:30-9:30 a.m. for breakfast and 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. for lunch and will be available from June 6 through Aug. 5, 2016 at **Copperview, East Midvale, Midvale, Midvalley, Sandy elementary schools and Union Park Middle**, with **Union Park** serving lunch only. Beginning June 20, meals will be served at **Hillcrest High**. Breakfast will be served from 7:30-8 a.m. and lunch will be served from 11:45 a.m.-12:15 p.m. Adults may purchase meals at these sites for the price of \$2 for breakfast and \$3.50 for lunch. Meals will not be available July Fourth and July 25 in observance of the Fourth of July and Pioneer Day holidays. No meal service is available on Saturdays or Sundays.
