Call to Order

Minutes from last month's meeting: Motion to accept minutes by Casey, seconded by Camie, approved by all.

Academic:	Core 5 - Oct. 8th usage was 83%, now up to 86%. Oct. 8th - 375 kids below GL. We are now 285 below GL. Oct. 8th - 3% above GL, now at 22%. 177 kids on track, 125 some risk, 162 high risk to meet end of year benchmarks. Problems are SPED students. They are in Resource during Core 5 time. It's hard to get time for those kids on the computer. Aides from 8:45-9:00 could supervise students who need time on computer. Some teachers are making phone calls home to let parents know if their student could benefit from additional Core 5 time at home. Brooke made a list of places for Free Wi-Fi. Camie will put it in the newsletter.
Behavior:	Think Times: Currently we have 4 kids who have 6 think times. 1 with 5. 5 with 4. 26 with 2 or 3. 90 with 1. Camie said it is curtailing a lot of undesirable behavior.
Technology:	Digital Citizenship plan 2018-2019 - Casey Draper. Teacher Education - beginning of the year training and policy manual review. Faculty meeting presentation on laptop security and digital citizenship 11/20. Monthly emails are sent to each teacher with a Dig. Cit. tip. Student Education - all students are taught Dig. Cit. lessons in the technology booster by Melanie Green. Each is grade-level appropriate. Parent Outreach - A brochure about Dig. Cit. was sent home. At spring conferences, a booth will be set up with brochures and flyers, free resources from the FTC (Federal Trade Commission). The school website is linked to the district Parent Connections page. Camie will post tips periodically in the school newsletter.
Community Needs	Carnival Planning: PTA will help with gathering donations.
School Needs	Parking Lot issues - cutting in backwards. Parents using parking lot area as a drop-off. Parents and kids don't cross at crosswalk. School is ordering vests for teachers to help with identification. Spray paint places for Safety Patrol to put cones. Encourage kids to talk to their parents about crosswalk safety. Possible discussion for next year: Do we want to reverse teacher parking lot with parent drop-off? More drop-off space. 3 buses will easily fit in other lot. Could have a gate that can close and open as needed.

Core 5 Prize Ideas -	10 units = 1 star to hang up. Take picture with certificate and hang up or send home. School-wide goal - Camie would sleep on the roof of the school, dye hair. School goal - get all but 100 kids on grade level. Whoever has highest minutes divided by number of units (to see the average) would win lunch for the class. Could do twice a year. Could do individual students as well. Top 10 kids in the school would win big prize. Grade Level - minute war. Kid that made the most growth over the school year. Make 2 grade levels growth, get a reward. Camie will craft an email with ideas and will send to SCC to finalize plan.
