Land Trust: measured goals.

Kindergarten growth according to PSF in Acadaience 9% from winter to spring and 75% of students scored at or above benchmark.

1st grade 6% of the students made growth from Winter to spring according to the Acadaience pathway to progress report and 52% of students scored at or above benchmark.

2nd grade 11% of the students made growth from Winter to spring according to the Acadaience pathway to progress report and 80% of students scored at or above benchmark.

3rd grade 9% of the students made growth from Winter to spring according to the Acadaience pathway to progress report and 82% of students scored at or above benchmark.

4th grade growth on RI report had 61% of the students making average or above average growth.

5th grade growth on RI report had 59% of the students making average or above average growth.
