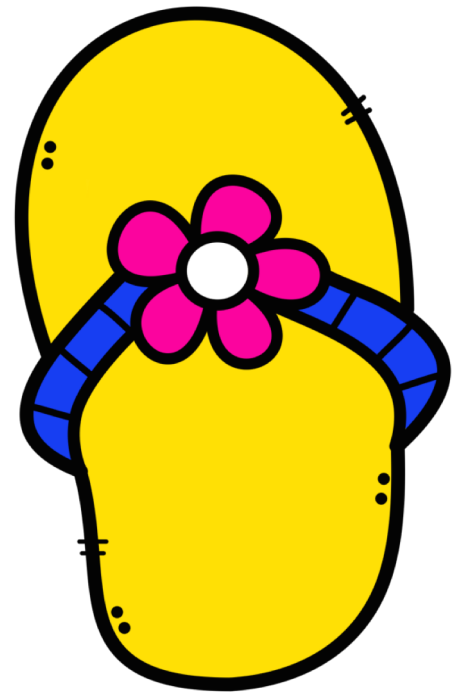
OUR SCHEDULE

Tuesday and Thursday.

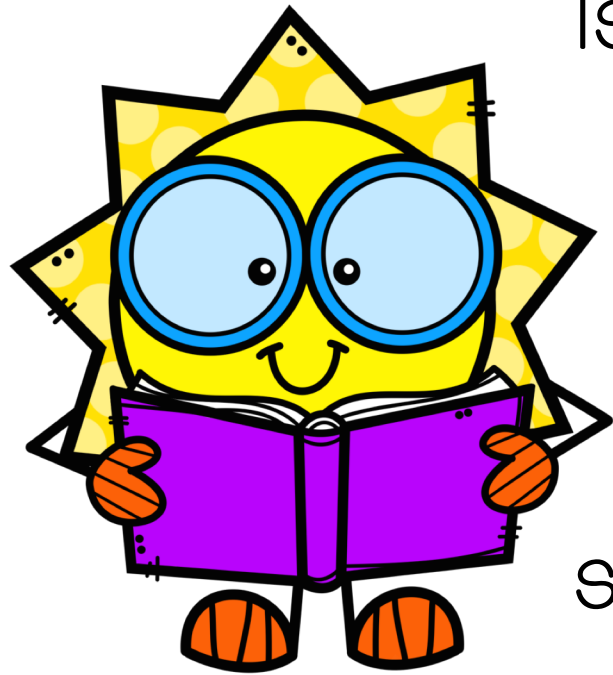
The first bell rings at 8:55

MATH

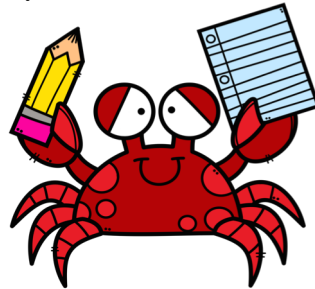
1st graders will learn to:

- add a 2-digit number and a 1-digit number with regrouping
- solve word problems
- tell time to the hour and half hour
- ... and lots more!



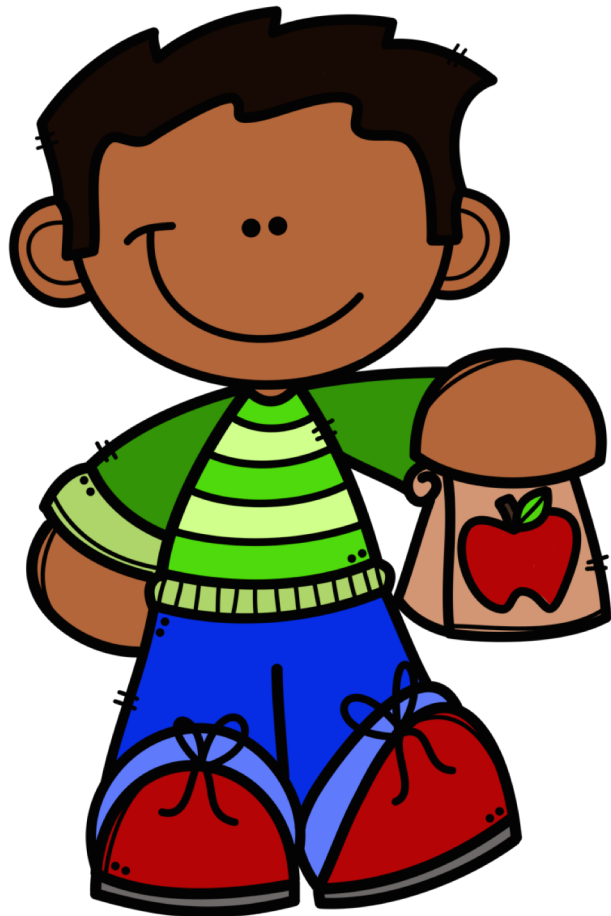
HOMework
