Reminder notices for attendance will be sent out after 10 and 15 days of absence excused or unexcused. Please contact us with extenuating circumstances.

All work missed must be made up

Before and After School:

Breakfast is served at 8:30–8:55 AM

Study Buddy 8:00-9:00 AM

School starts at 9:00 AM

Students enter the building through grade level doors at 8:55 AM

Late students enter through main office doors.

Inside/Outside Days:

On good weather days, play outside and line up at 8:50 AM

On bad weather days, students will enter through Cafeteria or grade level doors.

Wear appropriate clothing for the weather

Students will stay inside under the following conditions:

Snowing, raining, lightning, or other inclement weather

Temperature is 25 degrees or less

Bad air quality in the red zone for all students, asthma students will stay in on yellow days

Tardies

Please send a written excuse with your child when he or she is late for school. All students must check in at the office after 9:00AM

Students Leaving School During School Hours

A parent must come to the office to check out a student. The student will be called to the office **once** the parent arrives in the office and completes the sign out procedure. Please plan your time accordingly. Students must be checked out **only** by those on their emergency contact list.

Personal Toys and Electronic Devices

- Do not bring any electronics to school, including cell phones
- Do not bring or toys to school including basketballs, footballs, and soccer balls

Medication

- Do not bring any over-the-counter medications to school
- Prescriptions from a doctor can be dispensed only in the front office, under adult supervision with the proper authorization forms having been filled out beforehand

Lost and Found

Lost and found articles are collected and kept in our Lost & Found cabinets located in the cafeteria and available during school hours for your convenience. Anything that is left after Parent/Teacher Conferences will be donated.

Busing

Only students that have approval can ride the bus. Do not ride home with bus student friends on the bus. We cannot make those accommodations.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP GUIDELINES

Drop-off for students in the morning – 8:30 AM:

Drop-off may begin at the “Begin Drop Off” sign in the right lane. Please pull forward, allowing students to exit your vehicle. If your student is let out before the cones, you may exit through the parking area.

Pick-up for students in the afternoon – 3:35 PM (Mon.-Thurs) & 1:55 PM (Fri.)

Designated drop-off and pick-up area- students may walk to cars using the crosswalk with the assistance of our Safety Patrol. Kindergarten students may stay in their kindergarten area.

School and Daycare bus students should walk on the small sidewalk on the north side of the chain link fence to the kindergarten area to await their bus arrival.

Students who walk home should:

Walk on the small sidewalk on the north side of the chain link fence and proceed to their respective homes. Walk on the sidewalk going south to their homes.
